

Getting Expert Brake Repair

The first indicator that you will need to take your car in for brake repair is an unusual noise when braking. While an occasional squeal is often nothing to be concerned about, regular noise probably means that you should seek expert brake repair help. Some of the situations that call for brake repair help are described below.

Squealing

Any noise from your brakes that goes on even when you are not braking is a sign that your brake pads may be worn out. When this happens, you should take your car to a reputable service for a thorough brake system inspection. If you hear a louder squeal than usual whenever you apply the brakes, your brake linings have probably crystallized, and their function is possibly impaired. This is also a situation that warrants a full brake inspection as early as possible.

Grinding

A deep grinding sound that occurs whether you are driving or hitting the brakes is a more serious condition affecting the brake and possibly the wheel. The most common causes are worn brake linings or wheel bearing problems. In any case, these are both potentially dangerous problems that can result in an accident, so you should seek brake repair assistance as quickly as possible.

Brake pedal floored This is obviously one situation where you have to take your car in for brake repair as soon as possible. There are many causes for such a problem, and it will definitely not solve itself no matter what the cause is. Your only alternative is to have your brakes inspected thoroughly by an expert, and have a proper repair procedure performed. If your brakes fail to function at all, you may have to call in for a towing service. Do not drive your car to the repair shop if your brakes aren't working no matter how nearby it is!

Brake light stays on If your brakes red light comes on AND stays on, you should get expert [brake repair](#) immediately. Even if your brakes appear to be functioning normally, there is no telling when they can suddenly fail, so you should take your car in for inspection immediately. If you feel that your brakes aren't functioning normally, you should probably call for a tow truck.

Any type of brake trouble should only be addressed by a competent and reputable professional. The safety of you and your family as well as of other people depend on properly functioning brakes, so you should only trust in a qualified professional for brake repair.
