

Florida Quail Hunting: Eliminate the Stress From Hunting

As a seasoned bird hunting pro you may be looking forward to the current Florida quail hunting season. Given that as most other hunting sports, quail hunting is also strictly regulated so as to allow the population of quail to remain stable, and hence the idea of controlled hunting times. While the Florida quail hunting season extends over a period of 2 or 3 months, there are certain restrictions on hunting, including the areas of hunt, the number of bird harvests permissible in a day, and the suitable hunting gear. These guidelines are put forth by the wildlife conservation organizations, and they also provide recommendations for safe hunting, which begins with a mandatory hunting license. Novice hunters can participate in the ongoing Florida quail hunting season as long as they are in possession of a valid hunting license, while residents of the state can even look at acquiring annual licenses or an extended validity 5 year hunting license.

Quail hunting in the US is regarded as a social sport and this gains significance when it comes to ensuring safety of the entire hunting party. Quail hunters usually take leisurely walks around wide open farmland, or even privately held forest area, so they are likely to find plenty of time to discuss stuff with others in the hunting party. But with this comes the disadvantage of distraction, since the hunter is prone to get sidetracked when they need to be alert, and this is especially true for novice hunters who must concentrate before shooting. For this reason, all hunters must wear bright hued vests and hats in fluorescent orange, since this is easily seen even from a distance be it open fields or dense forest land. Also the hunting group comprises pointing dogs and retrievers, which aid in alerting hunters of potential prey, and one needs to make certain of their safety as well. Since dogs tend to scamper around unpredictably, ground level shooting is best avoided and this means that quail that fly too close to the ground are not to be aimed.

Undoubtedly a popular hobby, Florida quail hunting offers great prospects even to novices who wish to attempt hunting. In any hunting party, novices get to shoot alongside quail hunting pros, and they may provide valuable insights to look for bird groups as also the best techniques to approach and make the kill. Hunting clubs also offer seasoned hunting guides and dogs to watch for and flush the quail out into the open. Quail hunting in Florida needs no special hunting gear, and hunters with ordinary shotguns are as equipped as a practiced hunter with more specialized guns. In fact lighter the shotgun the better the game, because quail hunting trips mean covering vast areas on foot.
