

Pods as Moving Storage Options

This is a great solution for people going through a renovation or remodel.

No fussy scheduling to stick to or work around. And if you are getting people to help you load things or move heavy boxes, you don't have to impose on them a certain time and date to be there to help you. You can have flexibility to cater to your helpers' schedules with pods.
